The Dayanand Anglo-Vedic Colleges Trust & Management Society has applied for according permission to open classes I to VII (EM) during the year 2012-2013 in Matrusri Colony, Miyapur of Serilingampally Mandal, R.R.Dist.

The Mandal Educational Officer, Serilingampally, R.R.Dist. has caused inspection in this regard and submitted his report in the reference 4th cited.

After careful examination of the proposals from the society and also as per the Inspecting Officer recommendation under reference 4th cited and in terms of the orders issued in the references 1st & 2nd cited, the District Educational Officer, Ranga Reddy District is hereby accord opening permission to classes I to VII (EM) during the year 2012-2013 in respect of Matrusri DAV Public School, Matrusri Colony, Miyapur, Serilingampally Mandal, R.R.Dt. with instructed to follow the following instructions.

1. That the society shall abide to the rules and regulations made in the Govt. Order 1st and 2nd cited above.
2. That the society shall provide the necessary amenities like accommodation, sanitary facilities, drinking water facilities, furniture, library, laboratory equipments, play field, required staff as per the pattern and other facilities are necessary before approaching the competent authority.
3. That the society shall apply for recognition by within (60) days at the latest duly fulfilling the conditions.
4. That the permission accorded is restricted to the same year only.
5. That this permission does not confer any right on the society for claiming reorganization.
6. That the permission to accorded to Dayanand Anglo-Vedic Colleges Trust & Management Society and no other society or body can open a school their behalf.
7. The permission is accorded to open the school premises in the locality and there shall not be any change in the premises or locality.
8. The society shall provide the necessary material even it is cost more than the deposit amount.
9. Proper and adequate parking area for vehicles shall be provided transporting the children to and fro the school.
10. Proper sanitation facility shall be provided for students especially for girl students.
11. Proper and adequate safety measures shall be taken for children within the school campus and also near the school premises.
12. The school follow the traffic and safety guidelines indicated by the police and fire services department.
13. The parent teachers associations meeting shall be conducted to sensitize the parents on the safety of the children.
14. The school shall have first aid kit and the teachers shall be treated in first aid.
15. The above permission is accorded purely on a temporary basis and is subjected to the reports of the State Level Inspection and Vigilance Committee fulfilling of all the requisite condition under the A. P. Education Act 1982 and if later found that the school has not fulfilled any requisites as stipulated, the permission now being given is liable to be withdrawn at once.
16. That the Educational Society shall follow the Examination schedule as per the time table issued by the DCEB and should conduct DCEB Question papers for Quarterly, Half-yearly, Annual and Pre-final examinations.
17. That the Educational Society should follow school timings as prescribed by Government in school academic calendar.
18. That the Educational Society shall not conduct any events for children which will harm to lives.
19. That the Educational Society shall not conduct classes on public holidays/summer holidays/short term holidays without permission from the undersigned.
20. That the Educational Society should constitute parents teachers committee and should conduct meetings with a committee once in a month.
21. That the Educational Society should not open counters for selling books/badges/stationery etc.
22. That the Educational Society should follow school timings as prescribed by Government in school academic calendar.
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25. That the Educational Society should constitute parents teachers committee and should conduct meetings with a committee once in a month.
26. That the Educational Society should not open counters for selling books/badges/stationery etc.
27. That the society/school shall abide by the provisions of Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 and the rules thereof.
28. That the school management shall admit in class I, to the extent of 25% of the strength of that class, children belonging to weaker sections and disadvantaged groups in the neighbourhood and provide free and compulsory elementary education till its completion. Provided, further that in case of pre primary classes also, its norm shall be followed.
29. That the society/school shall not collect any capitation fee and subject the child or his or her parents or guardians to any screen procedure.
30. That the school management shall not deny admission to any child
 - a) for lack of age proof if such admission is sought subsequent to the extended period prescribed for admission
 - b) on the ground of religion, caste or race, place of birth or any of them.
31. That the management of school shall ensure.
31. No child admitted be held back in any class or expelled from school till the completion of elementary education in a school;
32. No child shall be subjected to physical punishment or mental harassment;
 - i) No child is required to pass any board examination till the completion of elementary education
 - ii) Every child completing elementary education shall be awarded a certificate as laid down under Rule 23
 - iii) Inclusion of students with disabilities/special needs as per provisions of the Act
 - iv) The teachers are recruited with minimum qualifications as laid under section 23 (1) of the Act. Provided further that the current teachers who, at the commencement of this Act do not possess minimum qualifications shall acquire such minimum qualifications within a period of 5 years;
 - v) The teacher performs his/her duties specified under section 24 (1) of the Act and
 - vi) The teachers shall not engage himself in private teaching activities.
 - vii) That the management of school shall enroll students proportionate to the facilities available in the school as prescribed in section 19 of the Act.
 - viii) that the management of school shall maintain the standards and norms of the school as specified in section 19 of the Act.
33. No un-recognized class shall run within the premises of the school or outside in the same name of school.
34. That the school buildings or other structures or the grounds are not used during the day or night for commercial or residential purposes (except for the purpose of residence of any employee of the school) or for political or non-educational activity of any kind whatsoever
35. That the school is run by a society registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 (21 of 1860), or a public trust constituted under any law for the time being in force;
36. That the school is not run for profit to any individual, group or association of individuals or any other persons;
37. The accounts should be audited and certified by a Chartered Accountant and proper accounts statements of Accounts should be sent to the District Educational Officer every year.
38. The permission Code Number allotted to your school is **11333/A3/2011**. This may please be quoted for any correspondence with this office in future.
39. The school furnishes such reports and information as may be required by the by the Rajiv Vidya Mission / District Educational Officer from time to time and complies with such instructions of the State Government/Local Authority as may be issued to secure the continued fulfillment of the condition of recognition or the removal of deficiencies in working of the school.
40. The permission shall be withdrawn if the contravention of the provisions of the Act. The Rules and conditions of recognition is found and proved.
